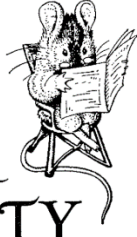

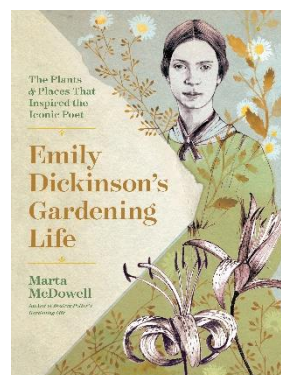
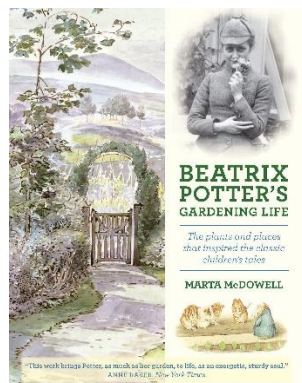
We are honored to welcome two speakers!

Marta is the 2019 Recipient of the ***Sarah Chapman Francis Medal (GCA)*** for inspiring generations of readers and gardeners with her magnificent portraits of literary figures and their gardens. Her many books include *Beatrix Potter's Gardening Life (2013)* and *Emily Dickinson's Gardening Life (2019)*. Her upcoming book will be *The Secret Garden (2022)*.
